# Teaching Grammar & Vocabulary

This course provides an introduction to all the essentials you need to know in order to start teaching grammar and vocabulary. The course consists of four ninety-minute sessions.

- **Session one** covers techniques for teaching grammar in context, use of timelines for the teaching of tenses, and concept check questions to ensure understanding.
- **Session two** covers techniques for teaching grammar through a text, using inductive and inductive methods, and the test-teach-test procedure.
- **Session three** covers background issues relating to the teaching of vocabulary and what it means to know a word.
- **Session four** covers a wide variety of creative techniques for teaching vocabulary at different levels.

## Aims and objectives

This course aims to provide a basic introduction to the teaching of grammar and vocabulary.

On completion of the course, participants should have a sound knowledge of basic techniques for teaching grammar and vocabulary, and the ability to use a variety of appropriate techniques.

## Entry requirements & Assessment

This course is open to all and assumes no prior knowledge of the subject. There is no assessment. Certificates of participation are awarded to all participants.
